### Job Summary

East Lyme Ambulance Fund, Inc. (ELAF) is seeking Emergency Medical Technicians (EMTs) to join our team. ELAF provides EMS services to the residents of, and visitors to, the town of East Lyme – a community of more than 18,000 residents, covering over 24 square miles, and responds to over 2,500 calls each year.

EMTs provide Basic Life Support patient care and medical transportation in accordance with State and local protocols. Using exceptional teamwork, communication, and problem-solving skills you will provide the highest level of care to patients whilst interacting with members of the public, and various first responder agencies including East Lyme Fire Service, East Lyme Police, and Lawrence & Memorial Hospital Paramedics, as well as other health care providers and hospital personnel.

**Job Type:** EMT-B.  
**Location:** East Lyme, CT.  
**Hours:** Up to 40 hrs. scheduled per week. Part-Time and Per Diem.  
**Salary:** \$18-\$24 based on experience level.

### Job Description:

- Responds to emergency medical calls, rides in emergency vehicle to scene, stabilizes and treats patients in accordance with State and Local Protocols, and assists in transporting to the most appropriate medical facility.
- Monitors patient vital signs using Basic Life Support techniques while enroute to medical facilities including performing emergency medical procedures when necessary.
- Maintains appearance and serviceability of department vehicle, checks inventory at the start of each shift, and following each call, and replaces equipment as necessary.
- Completes required pre-hospital care reports in a timely manner.
- Participates in in-service training for EMS and other training provided by other hospitals as necessary.
- Cleans and maintains uniform and personal equipment regularly.

### Minimum Qualifications

- Must be at least 18 years of age.
- High school diploma or GED.
- Current State of Connecticut EMT certification, or above, in good standing.
- Current American Heart Association CPR
- Valid Driver's License and an excellent driving record.
- In good standing with area hospitals.
